

PLANT FLOWER CARPET IN ANY SUNNY LOCATION

GROUND COVER

- Only 3 plants per square yard are required for full coverage
- On open ground for a splash of color, or in contrast to grass, shrubs or other ground covers
- On slopes, embankments and other difficult-to-cover areas
- As a lawn substitute—where its low maintenance cost can mean long-term savings compared with the upkeep of mown areas

BORDERS

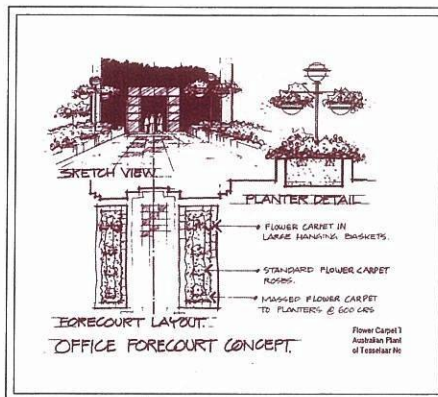
- For a year-round border or edge, plant Flower Carpet approximately 2 to 3 feet apart

POTS AND HANGING BASKETS

- Flower Carpet's vigorous growth habits are well suited to these feature plantings
- Plant in 10-inch containers or larger

INDIVIDUAL PLANTINGS

- Flower Carpet's long flowering season makes it continually impressive when featured as a shrub or as a highlight to contrast with other plants



RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS

- Public spaces
- Urban plans and designs with environmental implications
- Highway and median strip beautification—attention-getting separations of vehicle, bike and pedestrian traffic
- Intersections, verges, embankments and access points
- As surroundings to public buildings, office buildings and other commercial developments
- Gas stations, fast-food customer-parking areas and other parking lots
- Recreation areas, parks and streetscapes
